There are several different ways for students to run Linux at Cabrillo College.


Locations to work on lab assignments:


- CTC (Main campus, building 1400)

Classrooms:


- Room 2501 classroom (Main campus)

 - Putty access to Opus on all PC's


Putty Access to Opus






VMware Server for local Linux








PC's with Linux preloaded (Trios button II)
