



VMX file corruption fix



Edit the VMX file and change the .vmdk file line to match the actual file name

```
6 scsi0:0.present = "TRUE"
7 scsi0:0.fileName = "192-frodo-000001.vmdk"
8 ide1:0.present = "TRUE"

2) Add the following section at the end:

    Identifier "vmware"
EndSection
```

3) Restart X: `startx`
